Who is eligible?

The Local Sporting Champions program is designed to support young people participating in state, national and international level sporting championships as either an athlete, coach or official. AND meet the following criteria:

Be between 12 and 18 years of age (inclusive) at the time of the nominated sporting championship.

Be an Australian citizen or have been granted permanent resident status, residing in Australia.

Be participating as an athlete, coach, umpire or referee in:

Be living more than 125km from the championship venue, and travelling greater than 250km return to participate in the nominated championship.

Must complete and submit application to the ASC prior to the nominated championship commencing.

Grants of \$500 are available for successful individual applicants!
